1. Go to <https://www.flashalert.net/signup.html>
2. Create a Flash Alert account with your primary email address
3. Choose the **"Portland/Vanc/Salem"** option from the drop-down list of organizations
4. Choose the **"Columbia Gorge Schools"** option for the drop-down list that appears
5. Choose **"Glenwood Sch. Dist."** From the drop-down list that appears
6. Make sure that the **"Emergency Alerts"** check box is selected, then click **"Subscribe"**
7. Add more email addresses or text message numbers where you would like to receive alerts.  
Note: While there is no charge for signing up for this service, charges for receiving text messages vary depending on cell phone plans. Check your agreement for possible charges.
8. Send a test message to the email addresses and text message numbers by clicking the button at the bottom of the page.
