PRESCHOOL REGISTRATION

Registration for next year is now open for children who will be three and four years of age, by August 31st. To register parents need to provide documentation of the child's current immunizations and a copy of their birth certificate to the school office. Preschool students need to come to school being able to use the bathroom by themselves, follow classroom rules, share with other children, sit in a chair or circle and listen quietly, be respectful to the teacher and other adults and follow the teacher's directions. If students are unable do these things, they may not be ready to learn in a school setting.

FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

Summer is quickly ending and the 2018- 2019 school year will be upon us before we know it. School will resume on Wednesday, August 29th at 8:00AM. We look forward to welcoming all the new and returning students and staff. If there are any new students who are not yet registered, please come by or call the school. The school office is open from 9:00AM - 2:00PM daily. Please bring a copy of your child's immunizations, birth certificate and their high school transcript or their last report card when you register.

PRESCHOOL

The first day of preschool will be Tuesday, September 4th starting at 8:00AM and running until 10:40AM daily. Please be aware that preschool students are not allowed to ride the bus to and from school. Mrs. Arnold will be teaching preschool again this year. Please be sure to be on time for picking up your preschool student as Mrs. Arnold has other duties immediately following preschool.

KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

If there are any kindergarten students in the community who have not attended preschool at Glenwood School, they may register for kindergarten now in the school office. Kindergarten students must be age five by August 31st. Documentation of the child's current immunizations and a copy of their birth certificate are required before they can attend school.

A.S.B. CARDS

All students in grades 5th - 12th participating in sports and A.S.B. Officers must purchase an A.S.B. card. Prices for grades 5th - 8th are \$15.00 and for high school students the cost is \$20.00. A.S.B. cards can be purchased in the school office at any time. Glenwood A.S.B. cards will also be accepted for sports events held at the Klickitat School. Failure to purchase an A.S.B. if you are participating in sports will result in not being able to participate in contests.

EARLY DISMISSAL

School will be dismissed at 12:00PM on Wednesday, September 14th to allow our staff to attend First Aid/CPR training.

OPEN CAMPUS

Open campus during lunch is available to high school students only. If your child is entering kindergarten or the 6th grade there are required immunizations that they will need before the first day of school. See your health care professional or your local health department for more information. Letters were sent out to the parents of current students that need immunizations according to our school records.

SPORTS PHYSICALS

FIRST AID/CPR CLASS

There is a charge of \$55.00 per person and an additional charge of \$5.00 to receive a card. All charges must be paid prior to taking the class to the instructor. LUNCH PROGRAM

To remain in compliance with the National School Lunch Program paid lunch prices will be increasing by .05 cents for all students effective August 29, 2018. Lunch prices for students Preschool – 6th grade will be \$1.85 each and lunch prices for students in grades 7th – 12th will be \$2.30 each. If your child begins the new school year with a balance due on their meal account you will need to provide an alternate meal, until their account is paid in full, this includes ala carte items. This only applied to students that do not qualify for free or reduced meals. The USDA Child Nutrition Program does not require that a student who pays for regular priced meals be served a meal without payment. Please send your child to school with a sack lunch as this included no additional charging of meals, ala carte items or milk. Any payments will first be applied to past charges.
