CITIZEN OF THE MONTH

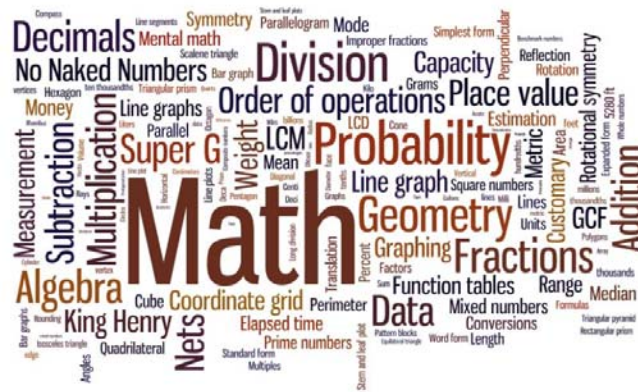

PRESCHOOL REGISTRATION

Registration for next year is now open for children who will be three and four years of age, by August 31st. To register parents need to provide documentation of the child's current immunizations and a copy of their birth certificate to the school office. Preschool students need to come to school with these basic skills: use the bathroom by themselves, follow classroom rules, share with other children, sit in a chair or circle and listen quietly, be respectful to the teacher and other adults and follow the teacher's directions. If students are unable do these things, they may not be ready to learn in a school setting.

FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

Summer is quickly coming to a close and the 2017- 2018 school year will be upon us before we know it. School will resume on Wednesday, August 30th at 8:00AM. We look forward to welcoming all the new and returning students and staff. If there are any new students who are not yet registered, please come by or call the school. The school office is open from 9:00AM - 2:00PM daily. Please bring a copy of your child's immunizations, birth certificate and their high school transcript or their last report card when you register.



NEW MATH CURRICULUM

PRESCHOOL

The first day of preschool will be Tuesday, September 5th. Their schedule will start at 8:15AM and run until 10:50AM daily. Mrs. Arnold will be teaching preschool again this year.

KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

If there are any kindergarten students in the community who have not attended preschool at Glenwood School, they may register for kindergarten now in the school office. Kindergarten students must be age five by August 31st. Documentation of the child's current immunizations and a copy of their birth certificate are required before they can attend school.

A.S.B. CARDS

All students in grades 5th - 12th participating in sports, band, or representing the school including A.S.B. Officers must purchase an A.S.B. card. Prices for grades 5th - 8th are \$15.00 and for high school students the cost is \$20.00. A.S.B. cards may be purchased in the school office at any time. Glenwood A.S.B. cards will be accepted for sports events held at the Klickitat School. Failure to purchase an A.S.B. if you are participating in sports will result in not being able to participate in contests.

EARLY DISMISSAL

School will be dismissed at 12:00PM on Wednesday, September 20th for a professional development day for staff.

YEAR BOOKS

Remind your child to bring their yearbook on Friday, September 8th. Students will be gathering in the multipurpose room from 2:15PM - 2:45PM to sign each other's yearbooks.

OPEN CAMPUS

Open campus during lunch is available to high school students only. In order to take advantage of open campus each student must have on file a signed permission slip with the student's and the parent's signature. Permission slips will be handed out the first day of school.

IMMUNIZATIONS

Just a reminder to make sure your child is up to date on their immunizations before the beginning of the school year. If your child is entering kindergarten or the 6th grade there are required immunizations that they will need before the first day of school. Once your child has received their immunizations, please inform Mrs. Troh so she can update their school records. See your health care professional or your local health department for more information. Letters were sent out to the parents of current students that need immunizations according to our school records.

SCHOOL DAY

The school day has been extended by 5 minutes, making the school day now from 8:00AM – 2:45PM. This change in the school day will allow teachers time to return to their classrooms after lunch. In the past there were no passing minutes from the end of the teachers lunch time to when class began, thus leaving students unattended and 5th period classes getting a few minutes late start every day. Buses will arrive at the school at 7:40AM to drop students off, with the first bell ringing at 7:55AM. Classes will begin at 8:00AM. School will be dismissed at 2:45PM. If you are new to the community and live on a bus route or have moved during the summer, please let Mrs. Troh in the office know so she can adjust the bus route and let you know what times the bus will be picking up your child.
